Continuity in the leadership of Sanitas

At yesterday's meeting, the Sanitas Krankenversicherung (foundation) board of trustees and the Sanitas Beteiligungen AG board of directors decided to make the interim management solution – with Ueli Dietiker as chairman of the board of directors and Otto Bitterli as CEO – a definitive one, with the timeframe running until 2021.

Following the change in CEO in January 2018, Ueli Dietiker took over as chairman of the board of directors and Otto Bitterli resumed his former CEO role, both on an interim basis. To allow Sanitas to find optimum succession solutions, the Sanitas Krankenversicherung (foundation) board of trustees and the Sanitas Beteiligungen AG board of directors decided at yesterday's meeting to make this interim leadership solution definitive. With a view to securing personnel continuity and stability in the years ahead, Sanitas has set a 2021 timeframe for the succession.

The meeting also saw Dr Luca Stäger voted in as the new vice chairman of the board of directors to replace existing vice chairman Dr Ivo Furrer.
